Breaking Open the Word:

STEP ONE: Listen to the Word

Suggested text for faith sharing--- II Corinthians 13:11-13

Theme: The mystery of the Trinity- Father, Son, Holy Spirit.

“Finally, brothers, rejoice. Mend your ways, encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you. Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the holy ones greet you. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the holy Spirit be with all of you.”

QUESTION 1 (for families and adults): As you hear this reading, what single line from St. Paul touches your heart? What is there in this reading that really speaks to your soul?
