

HIGH SCHOOL CONFIRMATION PROCESS AT HOLY NAME

FOR ALL GRADES: TO REGISTER, TAKE A REGISTRATION FORM AND RETURN IT TO THE PARISH CENTER WITH THE FEE.

For the Eighth and Ninth Grade Years

At Holy Name of Jesus, students in **Grades 8 and 9**, in whatever high school they are enrolled, are asked to:

- 1) **Attend an evening meeting in the fall, with at least one parent or guardian at an evening meeting**, to meet others in the program and to have the program and its requirements clearly discussed.
- 2) Attend a **Parish Youth Retreat** on at HNJ Parish Center. (This Retreat is required even if there is a class retreat at any students' high school).
- 3) Register each year through the Parish for Confirmation and pay the \$35.00 registration fee, which covers the cost of the Retreat and any other materials needed.

NB: CCD Students must continue to take Religious Education Classes throughout High School to be eligible to receive Confirmation in the 11th Grade.

For the Sophomore Year

In the tenth grade year, regardless of the school they attend, are asked to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation in a series of sessions. These classes will be held in the fall and the spring, and will be at Holy Name of Jesus School building, from 7:00 – 8:30 PM.

The students will be asked to attend the 6:00 PM Mass on those evenings that they are having class.

They will likewise have to do two service projects and report on them.

They will also be asked to attend a Youth Retreat. By having the sessions in the tenth grade year, the students are thus prepared to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in either the fall or spring of their junior year of high school.
